History

Founded in 1974 as part of the Okemos (Michigan) Community Education program, the Meridian Community Band (MCB) became an independent, non-profit organization in 1983. The mission of the MCB is to provide an opportunity for community musicians to come together in an enjoyable and cooperative atmosphere to practice, perfect, and perform inspiring and educational concerts in the American town band tradition for the benefit of the greater community.

The band performs nine to twelve concerts per season in a wide variety of settings. Annual events include the Grand Sousa Concert honoring legendary bandmaster John Philip Sousa, and the Red Cedar Festival of Community Bands. Our holiday series concerts benefit local area food banks and the "Toys-for-Tots" program. Outdoor summer concerts in area parks and bandshells bring our concert season to a close.
